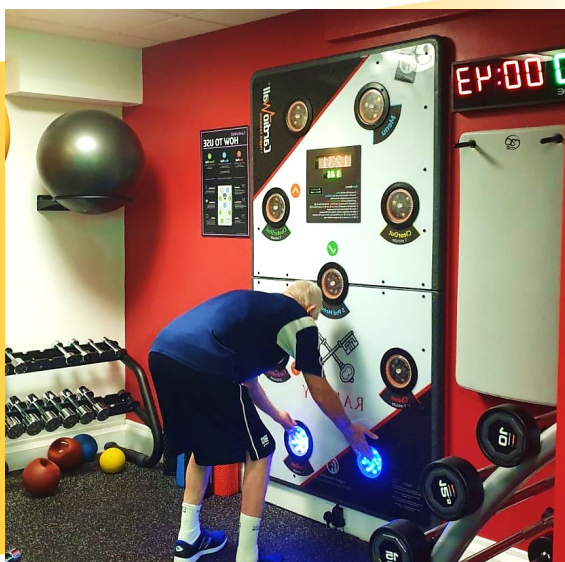
A snapshot of Radley College:
